Dr. Craig Mertler



Dr. Craig Mertler is the Director of the Doctoral Program in School Improvement and Professor in the Department of Educational Leadership and Professional Studies at the University of West Georgia,. Prior to coming to UWG, he was a professor of assessment and research methodologies at Bowling Green State University for 13 years. Dr. Mertler holds an undergraduate degree in Secondary Science Education from BGSU, a M.A. in Educational Research and Evaluation from The Ohio State University, and a Ph.D. in Educational Evaluation and Measurement from Florida State University.

His keynote address, “Learning Communities and Data-Driven Educational Decision Making: You Can Do It!” will consist of providing the ever-increasing accountability at all levels of education, the need for systematic and well-informed decision-making process that can be implemented in P-12, as well as higher education settings. The model incorporates elements and aspects of learning communities, collaboration, reflection, and action research—integrated and focused into a process of data-driven educational decision making.

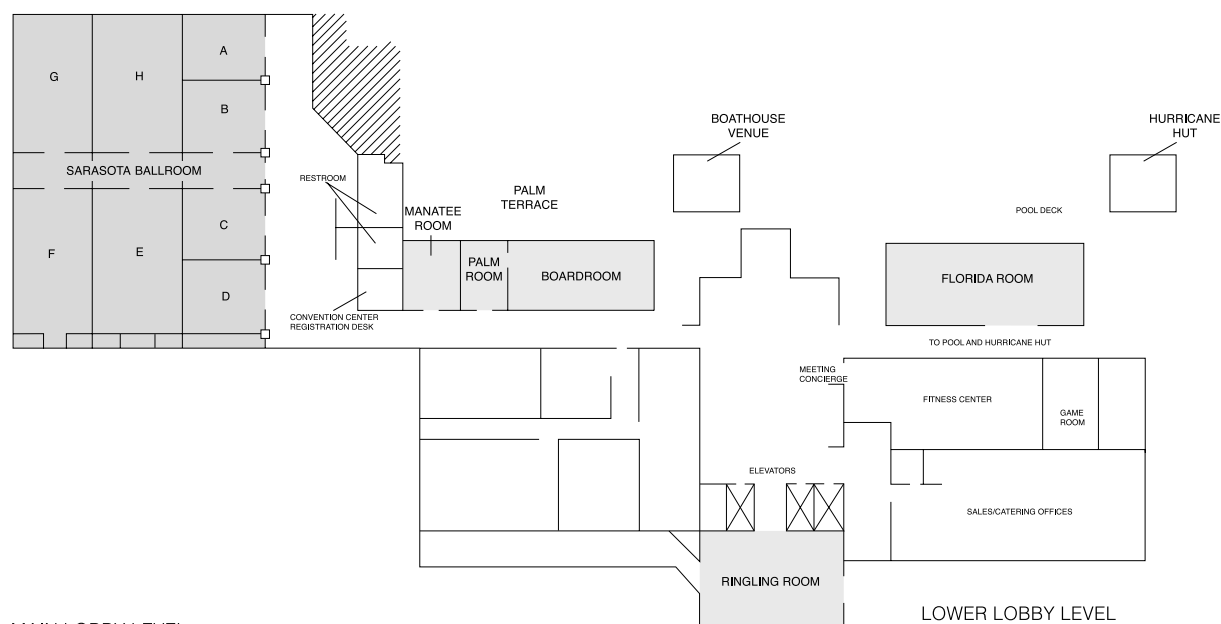

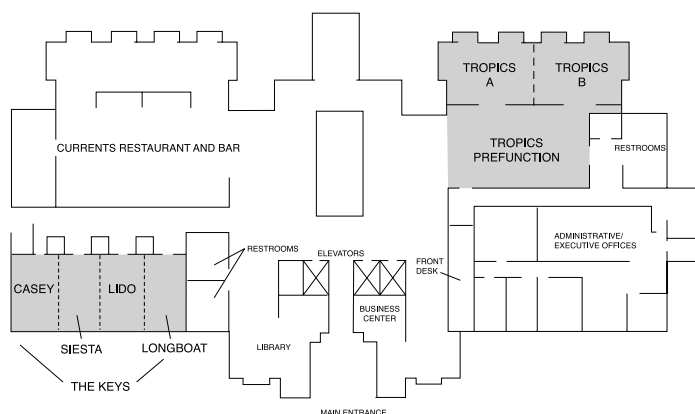

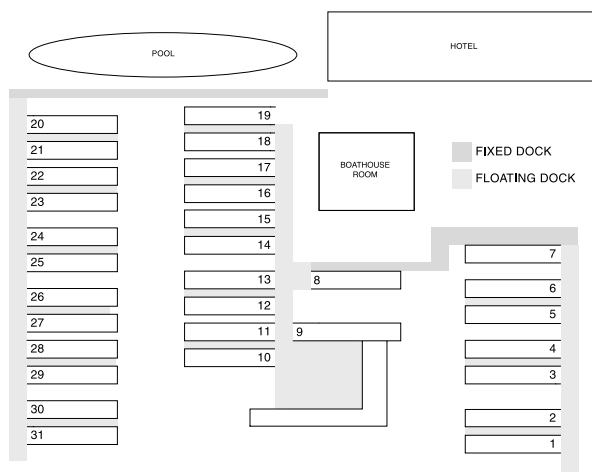
