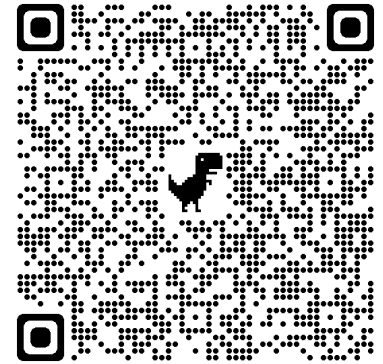
MESSAGE FROM THE VICE-PRESIDENT FOR CONFERENCE PLANNING
