THINGS TO KNOW

Requirements

Editorial board members **must be peers whose judgement is respectfully regarded within the journal's primary discipline**. Scholarly productivity/contribution and academic aptitude, appropriately comparable to one's career stage and professional designation/status, are the top considerations for editorial board membership.

How to Join

Editorial Board members are selected by the journal's editor(s), with input from the key executive leadership members (President-Elect, President, and Immediate Past President) and other leadership team member/s when needed. The standard term for serving on the Editorial Board is three years, with an eligibility to continue for another term.

Responsibilities

The Editorial Board should assist in a variety of aspects of the operation of the journal. Their responsibilities may include (but are not limited to):

- Providing scientific expertise for the journal
- Submitting articles
- Serving as a peer reviewer
- Helping the journal to attract high-quality manuscripts, for example by promoting the journal at relevant conferences
- Providing feedback and suggesting improvements for the journal
- Suggesting topics and authors for commissioned reviews and other types of creative works



Nomination Process and Information Needed

Nomination and self-nomination are welcome. Please submit a PDF file to Dr. Grace Liang at eerajournal@gmail.com, that includes the following information:



1. Full contact information (academic/professional position, organizational affiliation, email, work phone number)
2. A biographic statement to address why you would like to serve and your fitness to serve (no more than 2 pages)
3. A vita (no more than 6 pages)
4. One-page expertise inventory (list and rank your field of research, research interests, and methodological expertise)
